REQUIREMENTS

- Within range of an airCloud WiFi Access Point
- Windows, Mac, Linux, or any other Operating System with WiFi Support
- Any device with 802.11b/g Wireless Network Adapter
- Understanding of how to connect to wireless networks
- Up-to-date firewall and antivirus protection
- Optional external wireless adapter, external antenna, or wireless repeater.

GETTING CONNECTED

If you are within range of an airCloud wireless access point, connecting is as easy as 1-2-3:

- 1. Set your computer to obtain an IP address automatically
- 2. Connect to the wireless network aircloud-free-wifi
- 3. Once connected, simply open your Web Browser

WIRELESS ADAPTERS

Most laptops and many handheld devices are equipped with a built-in wireless network adapter and wireless networking configuration utility. Consult your user manual for instructions on connecting to wireless networks.

BOOSTING SIGNAL

Laptops:

- 1. Face the display toward the access point
- 2. Confirm the wireless adapter power is set to full
- 3. Use an external USB wireless adapter

Desktops:

- 1. Connect an external antenna and place in a window or outside
- 2. Use an external USB or Ethernet wireless network adapter
- 3. Use a wireless repeater with an external antenna
